Rather than being tucked away, the saunas are woven into the properties' design and broader wellness experiences, which include guided multisensory rituals and concierge-booked recovery sessions. In both the [Vue](#) and [Ombra](#), the saunas' defining feature isn't just the heat; it's also the glass. From the clarity of Vue to the reflective glow of Ombra, floor-to-ceiling glazing turns the [Thermasol](#) saunas into a frame for their surroundings, from a manicured Hamptons backyard to a rugged mountain vista or beach view. "The glass creates a unique sense of retreat while maintaining a connection to the surroundings, allowing you to enjoy a profound indoor wellness experience alongside the beauty of nature," Flaws says.



Thermasol Vue

Named after the French word for “view,” the Vue sauna features a panoramic glass facade that creates an open, light-filled experience at one with its surroundings. Modern yet warm, it provides privacy and tranquility with an immersive effect. Here, guests enjoy a private sauna while remaining visually engaged with the landscape.



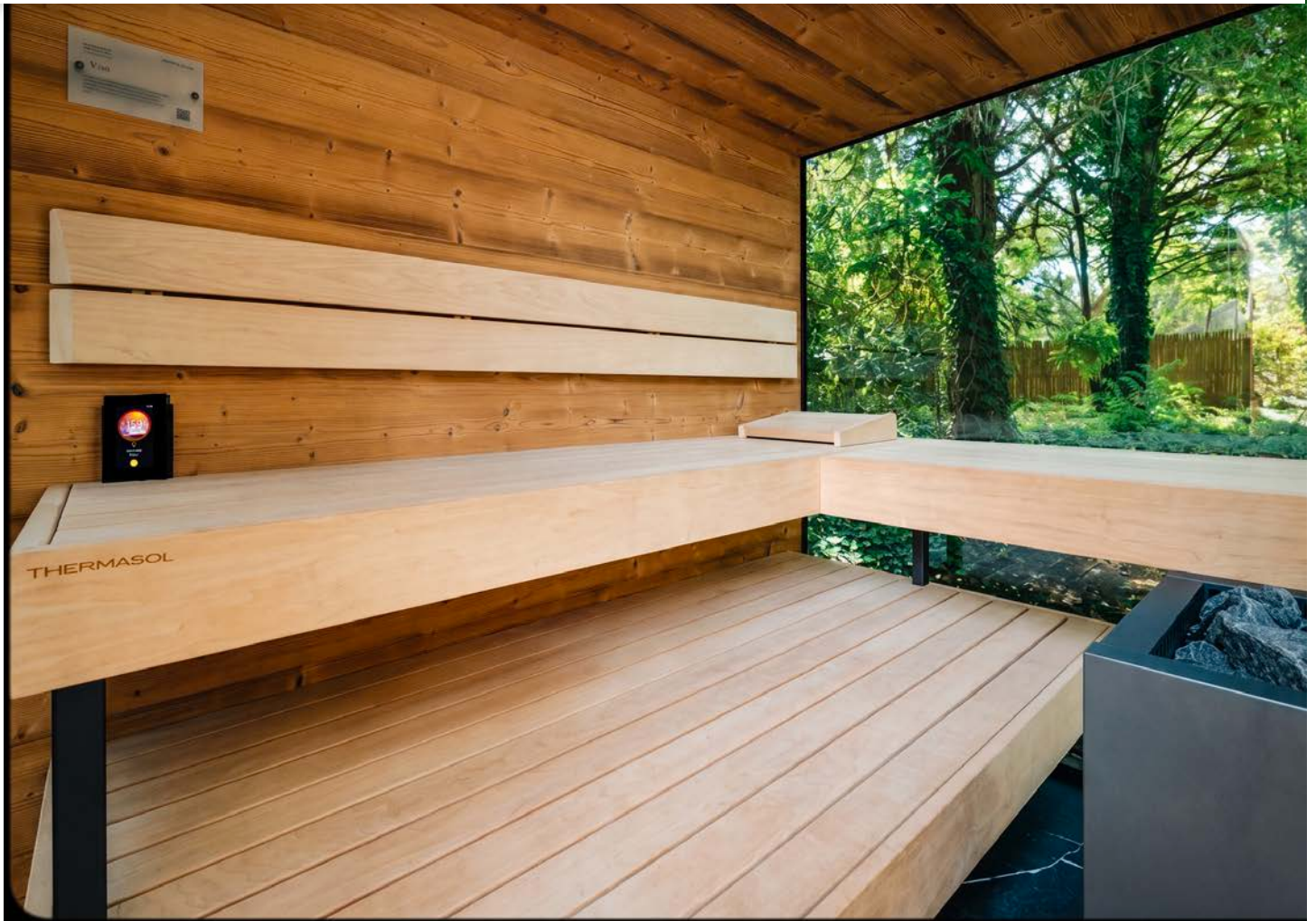

Ombra offers a more reflective expression of the same idea with tinted glass that emits a soft glow, and the sauna to respond to the changing light. Floor-to-ceiling windows draw the outdoors in, while accented black thermal wood and Canadian Hemlock give the structure a natural yet contemporary presence. These models illustrate how glass can shape a sauna's appearance, atmosphere and emotional quality," Flax
